Mission

- In partnership with 140 countries worldwide, the Fulbright US Scholar Program offers faculty from all backgrounds opportunities to teach and/or conduct research.
- Our mission is to foster mutual understanding between nations, advance knowledge across communities, and improve lives around the world.

Four Key Distinctions

1. Awarding over 800 fellowships a year, the Fulbright US Scholar Program is **the largest fellowship program for scholars**
2. Fulbright is **a public diplomacy program**: Established by Congress and sponsored by the U.S. Department of State
3. Fulbright values applicants who **seek engagement, forge lasting connections, and strive for long-term impact**

4. Fulbright is Elite but not Elitist

- Fulbright is a highly selective fellowship program that seeks to represent the best of the United States in all its diversity
- We encourage the involvement of people from traditionally underrepresented audiences.
- Opportunities are open to people regardless of their race, color, national origin, sex, age, religion, geographic location, socioeconomic status, disability, sexual orientation or gender identity.

Eligibility for U.S. Scholar Program

- **U.S. citizenship**
- **Degree and experience**, as required by award:
 - Ph.D. or other terminal degree
 - MA and higher education teaching or professional experience
 - Professional and/or artistic experience with substantial accomplishments
 - Teaching experience as required
- **Fulbright U.S. Scholar alums are eligible**; two year waiting period between end of your last Fulbright U.S. Scholar award and next application

Application Components

Requirements:

- Application Form
- Project Statement
- Curriculum Vitae or Resume
- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Language Proficiency Report (if required)
- Letter of Invitation (if required)

Supplemental Materials:

- Course outlines or syllabi (for teaching)
- Select bibliography (for research)
- Portfolio submissions (for artists, architects, and journalists)
